

## **Types of Support available from KHNES**

### **Hub** (3 locations: Canterbury, Leybourne and Tonbridge).

- Pupils attend one of our 3 hubs and engage in a typical school day
- This is a short term provision of up to but not exclusively 12 school weeks.

### **Online Learning:**

- Delivery of live lessons as part of a small learning pod including support of a learning mentor.
- Pupils can access up to 12 hours per week of support for primary (KS2) and 15 hours for secondary.

### **Tuition:**

- In a small minority of exceptional cases, pupils receive one-to-one tuition, at the home or another space.

### **Outreach**

- Outreach workers support pupils in attending their home schools.

### **Advice & Guidance**

- A member of the KHNES team will provide advice and guidance to school staff on how to support and accommodate the young person's needs. This may also be used to seek more information if there are further questions or uncertainties regarding the referral made.

### **Residential Provision**

- We also deliver an education provision within a secure residential site in Staplehurst.
- Admission is under the control of NELFT; this is independent to the KHNES referral process.
