



Information regarding Centre Policy for determining teacher assessed grades in Summer 2021

Every centre is required to create a Centre Policy that reflects its individual circumstances regarding the determining of teacher assessed grades for Summer 2021.

However KHNES have been advised by JCQ that this does not apply to our centres given that we have not entered the pupils for their exams – this responsibility falls to the pupils home school of which they are dual rolled with.

All home schools will have their own policies and processes that KHNES will support. Liaison regarding work completed, assessments, normal ways of working and any other current information is in process with final documentation provided to Home schools by 21.05.21.

Any questions regarding individual grades should be directed to the pupils home schools where the policy in place acts to ensure the following:

- *To ensure that teacher assessed grades are determined fairly, consistently, free from bias and effectively within and across departments.*
- *To ensure the operation of effective processes with clear guidelines and support for staff.*
- *To ensure that all staff involved in the processes clearly understand their roles and responsibilities.*
- *To support teachers to take evidence-based decisions in line with Joint Council for Qualifications guidance.*
- *To ensure the consideration of historical centre data in the process, and the appropriate decision making in respect of, teacher assessed grades.*
- *To support a high standard of internal quality assurance in the allocation of teacher assessed grades.*
- *To support our centre in meeting its obligations in relation to equality legislation.*
- *To ensure our centre meets all requirements set out by the Department of Education, Ofqual, the Joint Council for Qualifications and awarding organisations for Summer 2021 qualifications.*
- *To ensure the process for communicating to candidates and their parents/carers how they will be assessed is clear, in order to give confidence.*
